Thar nan còig bliadhna ri teachd, dh'fhaodadh buaidh na cuimse amasaichte seo agus na builean a tha sinn a' sùileachadh a choileanadh ann an 2023/24, taic a chur ri 18,000 gu 21,500 obair iomlan a bharrachd (a' gabhail a-steach nam buadhan iomadachaidh air an eaconamaidh) agus £380 millean - £455 millean a thoradh ann an cìs teachd-a-steach ann an Alba.
